AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, relative to testing.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-6001, is amended by adding the following language as a new subsection (l):

(l) A student whose individualized education program (IEP) or section 504 plan under the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. § 701 et seq.) allows for testing accommodations shall be allowed to use the same testing accommodations while taking an assessment under the Tennessee comprehensive assessment program (TCAP) or an end-of-course assessment, required by the state board of education under subsection (a), as long as the accommodation does not invalidate the assessment.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
