

SENATE BILL 1651

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4 and Title 47, relative to regulation of artificial intelligence.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1.

(a) The Tennessee advisory commission on intergovernmental relations (TACIR) is directed to conduct a study on approaches to the regulation of artificial intelligence, including approaches taken within the United States and by other countries.

(b) All appropriate departments and agencies of this state shall provide assistance to TACIR in connection with the analysis required in subsection (a).

(c) TACIR shall submit a report disclosing the findings of the study and recommendations to the speaker of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the legislative librarian no later than January 1, 2025. The report must include recommended legislative approaches that, based on TACIR's findings from the study required by subsection (a):

(1) Provide a range of regulations that vary from the least restrictive to the most restrictive; and

(2) Emphasize a regulatory program that is consistent with approaches taken by other states.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
