AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 68, Chapter 3, Part 6, relative to maternal mortality.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-3-607(3), is amended by deleting the language:

Report at least biennially to the governor and the general assembly concerning the state team's activities and its recommendations for changes to any law, rule, and policy that would promote the safety and well-being of women and prevention of maternal deaths; and


and substituting the language:

Report at least annually to the governor and the general assembly concerning the state team's activities and its recommendations for changes to any law, rule, or policy that would promote the safety and well-being of women and prevention of maternal deaths; and

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
