## SENATE BILL 1812

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 22, relative to jury service by persons seventy (70) years of age or older.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

- SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 22-1-103, is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subsection:
  - (e) A person, who is seventy (70) years of age or older, shall be excused from jury service upon request; however, prior to excusing such person, the court may require sufficient proof of age.
- SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 22-2-306(a), is amended by adding the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:
  - (8) Process by which a person, who is seventy (70) years of age or older, may be excused from jury service pursuant to § 22-1-103(e).
- SECTION 3. Jury summons which do not comply with this act may be used until current supplies are exhausted and new forms are prepared.
- SECTION 4. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2014, the public welfare requiring it, and shall apply to persons summoned for jury service on or after such date.
