SENATE BILL 1871

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 3; Title 4 and Title 50, relative to legislative committees and commissions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 3-15-1001, is amended by deleting the section in its entirety and by substituting instead the following language:

Section 3-15-1001.

- (a) There is created a select oversight committee of the general assembly to be known as the charitable gaming oversight committee.
- (b) The oversight committee shall be composed of six (6) members. Three (3) senators shall be appointed by the speaker of the senate. Three (3) representatives shall be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives. During the organizational session of each general assembly, the respective speakers shall appoint, or reappoint, members to serve on the oversight committee. The committee shall elect from its membership a chair, a vice chair and such other officers as it considers necessary. Any vacancies occurring on the oversight committee, between organizational sessions, shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments by the respective speakers.
- (c) The oversight committee, at the call of the chair, shall periodically review and evaluate the operation of the Tennessee charitable gaming implementation law.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009, the public welfare requiring it.
