

SENATE BILL 1872

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 11,
Chapter 25; Title 54 and Title 55, relative to the
Doe Mountain recreation area.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 54, Chapter 5, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

The department is authorized to install and erect signs, other than tourist-oriented directional signs, along a state highway for the Doe Mountain recreation area. Such signs must be authorized by the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-8-185(c)(1), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision:

() State Route 167 from its intersection with Rainbow Road to its intersection with Dotson Lane, within the jurisdiction of Mountain City in Johnson County, which segment is approximately one-half (.5) mile.

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 11, Chapter 25, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

Upon request of the authority, the department of environment and conservation shall provide legal support services to the authority regarding property boundary disputes, contracts review, policy development, and other legal matters as may reasonably be required to enable the authority to efficiently perform its duties as provided in this chapter. The autonomy of the authority and its authority are not affected by this section, and the department shall have no supervisory control over the authority.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring
it.
