AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 17 and Title 68, Chapter 7, relative to qualifying medical diagnoses for the use of medical cannabis.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

- SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-402(16)(F)(ii)(b)(2), is amended by deleting subdivisions (G) and (H) and substituting:
  - (G) Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) or acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS);
    - (H) Sickle cell disease; or
    - (I) Quadriplegia; and

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
