## SENATE BILL 1883

## AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 4 and Title 55, Chapter 6, relative to registration period for license plates.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-4-104, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(f)

(1) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, an owner or lessee of a vehicle who has been issued, or is entitled under this chapter to be issued, a registration, may elect for the issuance of a registration that is valid for twentyfour (24) months, and expires on the last day of the last month of the registration period.

(2) Beginning July 1, 2018, if requested pursuant to subdivision (f)(1), the commissioner may establish a system of registration renewals at alternate intervals that allow for the distribution of the registration workload as uniformly as is practicable throughout the registration period.

(3) The department shall set twenty-four-month registration fees in an amount that offsets revenue that would otherwise be generated by twelve-month registration fees in effect prior to July 1, 2018.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it, and shall apply to plates issued or renewed on or after July 1, 2018.
