AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 2, relative to local boards of education.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-2-203, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

Notwithstanding any public or private act to the contrary, a local board of education's administrative office may be located within a building owned by the United States government, or an agency or instrumentality of the United States government, pursuant to a lease or easement authorized by the United States government.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
