## SENATE BILL 1887

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-10-312, relative to individual contribution limits.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-10-312, is amended by deleting such section in its entirety and substituting instead the following:

2-10-312.

- (a) No individual shall contribute more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) in the aggregate to all candidates, multicandidate political campaign committees, and political campaign committees controlled by a political party on the state or local level or by a caucus of such political party established by members of either house of the general assembly every two (2) years.
- (b) The campaign contribution limits in this section shall be increased to reflect the percentage of change in the average consumer price index (all items-city average) as published by the United States department of labor, bureau of labor statistics, on January 1 of every odd-numbered year starting in 2011. Any amount adjustment under this section shall be rounded to the nearest multiple of one hundred dollars (\$100). The registry of election finance shall publish the increased amount on its web site.

  SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009, the public welfare requiring it.
