## SENATE BILL 1942

## AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 70, relative to hunting where bait is present.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-4-113(a), is amended by deleting subsection (a) and substituting:

(a) Except as provided in this section, it is unlawful for a person to make use of a pitfall, deadfall, cage, snare, trap, net, baited hook, poison, chemical, explosive, set gun, spotlight, electric lights or torch, bait, which includes a grain, or mixture of ingredients used as or for food purposes, or other device for the purpose of killing, injuring, or capturing a bird or animal protected by the wildlife laws of this state.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-4-113, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

(d) It is not a violation of subsection (a) for a person to hunt on or over privately owned land where bait is present. A person shall comply with § 70-4-120 when seeking to hunt or hunting on or over land owned by another person.

SECTION 3. This act takes effect July 1, 2024, the public welfare requiring it.
