SENATE BILL 1947

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, relative to course requirements.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE: SECTION 1.

- (a) The state board of education, in collaboration with the department of education, shall conduct a study to identify math courses that may be substituted for Algebra II for purposes of satisfying high school graduation requirements.
- (b) By October 15, 2024, the state board shall submit a report of the math courses that the state board has identified as suitable for addition to the state board's list of approved high school courses as a substitute for Algebra II to the education committee of the senate, the education administration committee of the house of representatives, and the education instruction committee of the house of representatives.
- (c) This act does not diminish the state board's authority to establish high school graduation requirements or to approve high school courses.
- SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
