AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 1, Part 4, relative to time.

WHEREAS, this General Assembly intends by this act to exempt the state from the provisions of the Uniform Time Act of 1966 (15 U.S.C. §§ 260a) commonly referred to as daylight saving time; now, therefore,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-1-401, is amended by adding the following language as a new subsection:

(d) This state exempts itself from the observation of the advancement of time between two o'clock a.m. (2:00 a.m.) on the second Sunday in March each year and ending at two o'clock a.m. (2:00 a.m.) on the first Sunday of November of the same year. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
