AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 10, Chapter 7 and Title 38, relative to law enforcement body camera video.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-504, is amended by deleting subdivision (u)(5) and substituting:

(5) This subsection (u) is deleted on July 1, 2027, and will no longer be effective on and after that date.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-504(u)(1)(A), is amended by deleting the subdivision and substituting the following:

(A) Minors, when taken within a:

- (i) School that serves any grades from kindergarten through grade twelve (K-12);
- (ii) Child care agency, as defined in § 71-3-501;
- (iii) Child care program, as defined in § 49-1-1102;
- (iv) Preschool; or
- (v) Nursery school;

SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it, and expires on July 1, 2027.
