

SENATE BILL 2171

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2,
relative to information on voter applications.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-2-116, is amended by deleting the language "Social Security number, if any" and substituting instead the language "Last four digits of your Social Security number, if any" on the permanent registration record.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-6-202(a)(3), is amended by deleting subdivision (D) and substituting instead the following:

(D) The last four digits of the voter's social security number;

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-6-502(b), is amended by deleting the language "social security number" wherever it appears and substituting instead the language "last four digits of the applicant's social security number".

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-7-112(a)(2), is amended by deleting the language "social security number" and substituting instead the language "last four digits of the voter's social security number".

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-7-112(a)(3)(A)(iii), is amended by deleting the language "social security number" and substituting instead the language "last four digits of the voter's social security number".

SECTION 6. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-7-112(e)(2), is amended by deleting the language "social security number" and substituting instead the language "last four digits of the voter's social security number".

SECTION 7. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-11-202(a)(16), is amended by deleting the language "social security number" and substituting instead the language "social security number or last four digits of the voter's social security number".

SECTION 8. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016, the public welfare requiring it.
