HOUSE BILL NO. 2029

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-4-723, relative to county clerk fees for issuance of business licenses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-4-723, is amended by adding at the end of subdivision (a)(1) the following language:

In the case of the county clerk, three dollars (\$3.00) of the fifteen-dollar fee shall be earmarked for computer hardware purchases or replacement, but may be used for other usual and necessary computer-related expenses at the discretion of the county clerk. The earmarked amount shall be preserved for these purposes and shall not revert to the general fund at the end of a budget year if unexpended.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
