

SENATE BILL 2244

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 54-21-104, relative to the annual renewal of outdoor advertising permits.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 54-21-104, subsection (c), is amended by designating the existing language as paragraph (1) and adding the following language as a new paragraph (2):

(2) In the event that a permit has not been renewed by December 31 for the following year as required in this subsection, the permit shall not be considered void until the commissioner has given notice of the failure to renew, which notice shall be given in the manner provided in § 54-21-105(b). The notice shall specify that failure to renew the permit may be remedied within thirty (30) days by submitting a late renewal form and paying a late renewal fee in the amount of two hundred dollars (\$200). Otherwise the permit shall be considered void and the outdoor advertising device shall be considered unlawful and subject to removal as provided in § 54-21-105.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
