AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 1, relative to periods of observance.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 1, Part 4, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

The month of November is designated as "Christian Heritage Month" to encourage citizens to learn more about Christian heritage in this state.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
