SENATE BILL 2382

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-3018, relative to special circumstances under which students are to be credited as present.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. The Tennessee Code Commission is requested to change the heading of § 49-6-3018 from "Children serving as pages for general assembly." to "Special circumstances under which students are credited as present.".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-3018, is amended by deleting the section and substituting instead:

- (a) The school in which a student is enrolled shall credit the student as present in the same manner as the school credits the student present for participation in an educational field trip when the student:
 - (1) Serves as a page of the general assembly during the school year, either at a regular or special session; or
 - (2) Visits an institution of higher education as a prospective enrollee. To be credited as present for a visit to an institution of higher education, the student must provide to the student's school documentation of the visit from the institution's admissions office or an official of the institution.
- (b) The school shall not count the student's service as a page or visit to an institution of higher education as a prospective enrollee under subsection (a) as an absence, either excused or unexcused.

(c) A local board of education must adopt a policy governing student visits to institutions of higher education before crediting any student as present when the student is visiting an institution of higher education as a prospective enrollee.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it, and shall apply to students serving as pages of the general assembly or visiting institutions of higher education as prospective enrollees in the 2018-2019 school year and school years thereafter.
