AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 62, Chapter 6, relative to licensing of contractors.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-6-116, is amended by deleting subsection (d) and substituting:

(d) A renewal application for a monetary limitation greater than one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) must be accompanied by a compilation prepared by a licensed public accountant or a certified public accountant. If a renewal applicant requests a monetary limitation of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) or less, then the applicant must submit a notarized statement that the information contained in the financial statement is true and correct. The board may, with cause, require a financial statement of the applicant that is reviewed or audited and attested to by a licensed public accountant or certified public accountant if the board has reason to believe it is in the best interest of the public safety and welfare.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
