SENATE BILL 2446

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57, Chapter 1; Title 57, Chapter 3; Title 57, Chapter 4 and Title 57, Chapter 5, relative to the regulation of certain high alcohol content beverages.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57, Chapter 1, Part 2, is amended by adding the following as a new section thereto:

57-1-213.

- (a) The commission shall promulgate rules and regulations to place further restrictions on the sale of any alcoholic beverage with an alcohol content of greater than fifty percent (50%) by weight.
 - (b) Such restrictions shall include:
 - (1) Requiring retail package stores to place a limit on the sale of such products to a customer in one day; and
- (2) Limiting the amount of such products sold or served to a single customer in one day at a location that has an on-premises consumption license.
 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
