

SENATE BILL 2598

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 54,  
relative to erection of a monument at the Clinch  
Mountain overlook on U.S. Highway 25E in  
Grainger County, Tennessee, in honor of Kim  
Williams.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1.

(a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the department of transportation is directed to erect a memorial monument at the Clinch Mountain overlook on U.S. Highway 25E in Grainger County, Tennessee, which is near 6621 Hwy 25E, Thorn Hill, Tennessee, 37881, to honor the memory of Kim Edwin Williams, a songwriter and inductee of the Nashville Songwriters Hall of Fame, who died on February 11, 2016, and whose birthplace is the City of Kingsport, Tennessee.

(b) The costs of the erection of the memorial monument at the overlook described in subsection (a) shall be paid by the requesting municipality or county or any person or entity other than the state.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
