

SENATE BILL 2610

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49,
Chapter 10, Part 14, relative to student eligibility
for an individualized education account.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-10-1402, is amended by deleting subdivision (3) and substituting instead:

(3) "Eligible student" means a resident of this state who:

(A) Has an active individualized education program (IEP) in accordance with 34 C.F.R. § 300 et seq., § 49-10-102, and regulations of the state board of education in effect at the time the department receives the request for participation in the program; and

(B) Meets at least one (1) of the following requirements:

(i) Was previously enrolled in and attended a Tennessee public school for the one (1) full school year immediately preceding the school year in which the student receives an individualized education account

(IEA);

(ii) Is enrolling in a Tennessee school for the first time; or

(iii) Received an individualized education account (IEA) in the previous school year;

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018, the public welfare requiring it.
