SENATE BILL 2618

AN ACT to amend Chapter 280 of the Acts of 1909; as amended and rewritten by Chapter 99 of the Private Acts of 2000; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the charter of the Town of Gordonsville.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 280 of the Acts of 1909, as amended and rewritten by Chapter 99 of the Private Acts of 2000, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended in Section 9 by deleting the language "All legislative acts of the Board shall be in ordinance form and shall be considered and adopted on three (3) separate days" and by substituting instead the language "All legislative acts of the Board shall be in ordinance form and shall be considered and adopted on two (2) separate days".

SECTION 2. Chapter 280 of the Acts of 1909, as amended and rewritten by Chapter 99 of the Private Acts of 2000, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended in Section 11(4) by deleting the fourth sentence and by substituting instead the following:

No ordinance shall become a law unless the same shall have passed two (2) separate readings on two (2) separate days by a majority vote of the Board, unless by unanimous consent of the Board earlier action is deemed necessary, and unless the same shall have been signed by the Mayor, unless he fails to veto the same by the next regular meeting.

SECTION 3. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of the Town of Gordonsville. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 4. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 3.
