AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, Chapter 4, relative to the Tennessee Promise scholarship.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-4-708(c)(1), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision:

(C) Notwithstanding subdivision (c)(1)(A), if a student who graduates early from an eligible high school, or who completes high school at an eligible home school early, or who obtains a GED® or HiSET® diploma before the spring semester immediately preceding the student's initial fall enrollment, and the student is admitted to, and enrolled full-time in, an eligible postsecondary program, then the student is eligible for the scholarship;

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
