

SENATE BILL 2666

AN ACT to amend Chapter 91 of the Private Acts of 2008; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the appointment of city judge for the city of Jellico.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 91 of the Private Acts of 2008, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting Section 3.05(a) and substituting instead the following:

(a) Qualifications. The City Judge shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by majority vote of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen. The City Judge shall be a citizen of the United States and shall be licensed to practice law before the Courts of the State of Tennessee. The City Judge shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Jellico, and shall receive such compensation as the Board of Mayor and Aldermen shall establish from time to time.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of the city of Jellico. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.
