SENATE BILL 2820

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55; Title 69 and Title 70, relative to wildlife resources agency licenses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-2-202(c), is amended by deleting the subsection in its entirety and by substituting instead the following language:

(c) Any nonresident between thirteen (13) years of age and fifteen (15) years of age, inclusive, may purchase a junior hunting and fishing license. Such license entitles the individual to the privilege of sport fishing and small game and waterfowl hunting. Any nonresident under thirteen (13) years of age is exempt from the licensing requirements of subsection (a). Nonresidents between thirteen (13) and fifteen (15) years of age, inclusive, are entitled to fish without a license during one (1) week of the year, commencing with free sport fishing day as proclaimed by the wildlife resources commission.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010, the public welfare requiring it.
