AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40, Chapter 30, relative to post-conviction procedure.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

- SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-30-106(f), is amended by designating the existing language as subdivision (1), and is further amended by adding the following language as subdivision (2):
 - (2) Notwithstanding subdivision (f)(1), the petitioner shall not be permitted to raise any issue that could have been raised at trial, on appeal, or could have been made as a complaint to the court at or prior to the plea proceeding if:
 - (A) The petitioner entered a guilty plea or other plea agreement with the state:
 - (B) The court, in accepting the plea, complied with rule 11 of the Tennessee Rules of Criminal Procedure by advising petitioner of petitioner's rights;
 - (C) The petitioner assured the court that the petitioner understood those rights;
 - (D) The petitioner assured the court that the petitioner was satisfied with petitioner's attorney; and
 - (E) The petitioner assured the court that the petitioner wanted to accept the plea agreement.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2010, the public welfare requiring it.
