## SENATE BILL 3200

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, Chapter 10, relative to multicandidate political campaign committees.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, Chapter 10, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section thereto:

- (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the governor or any member of the general assembly is prohibited from creating or controlling a multicandidate political campaign committee while such person is in office.
- (b) Any multicandidate political campaign committee created or controlled by the governor or a member of the general assembly before the effective date of this act shall close out such account on or before January 1, 2011.
- (c) This section shall not apply to political campaign committees controlled by a political party on the national, state, or local level or by a caucus of such political party established by members of either house of the general assembly.
