AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 16, Chapter 18 and Title 18, Chapter 4, relative to notification to the Tennessee bureau of investigation of final disposition of criminal proceedings.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 18-4-103(9), is amended by adding "by electronic submission" after "Tennessee bureau of investigation".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 18-4-103(9), is amended by deleting "thirty (30) days" and substituting "seventy-two (72) hours".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 18-4-203(b)(4), is amended by adding "by electronic submission" after "Tennessee bureau of investigation".

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 18-4-203(b)(4), is amended by deleting "thirty (30) days" and substituting "seventy-two (72) hours".

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 16-18-310, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:


(c) The clerk of the municipal court, when exercising concurrent general sessions court jurisdiction, shall notify the Tennessee bureau of investigation by electronic submission of final disposition of criminal proceedings against a person as soon as practicable but no later than seventy-two (72) hours after final disposition of the criminal proceedings.


SECTION 6. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
