SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 127

A RESOLUTION to require TACIR to perform a job analysis study of the members of the general assembly.

WHEREAS, a job analysis study of the duties and compensation rates of the members of the Tennessee general assembly shall provide guidance to the members of the general assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that the Tennessee Advisory Committee on Intergovernmental Relations (TACIR) is directed to perform a study of the Tennessee per diem structure and compensation of each member of the general assembly. TACIR is also directed to perform a job analysis study that includes, but is not limited to, the number of counties that each member represents; the population of each members' district; the number of square miles in district; the number of local and county governments, including the number of mayors in each district; and the distance to and from Nashville from each district.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all appropriate state departments and agencies shall provide assistance to TACIR.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that TACIR is requested to report its findings and recommendations upon conclusion of its study to the chairs of the state and local government committee of the senate, the state government committee of the house of representatives, and the local government committee of the house of representatives.
