

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 214

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Dr. Chad Lewis to the standards recommendation committee for science and social studies.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-313, creates a standards recommendation committee for science and social studies; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-312(a), provides that the governor shall appoint four members to the standards recommendation committee for science and social studies; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Lee has appointed Dr. Chad Lewis to serve on such committee for a term that expires on January 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, a longtime educator, Dr. Lewis currently serves as the assistant principal of Lenoir City Intermediate School; he previously served as a fourth grade social studies teacher, an eighth grade social studies and ELA/reading teacher, a social studies academic coach, and the special education director; and

WHEREAS, he is a graduate of the University of Tennessee and holds an education doctorate degree from Trevecca Nazarene University; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-1-312(b), provides that all appointments to the committee "shall be subject to confirmation by the senate and the house of representatives"; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRTEENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that we confirm the appointment of Dr. Chad Lewis to

the standards recommendation committee for science and social studies for a term that expires on January 31, 2024.
