A RESOLUTION to recognize Captain John Huffine on the occasion of his retirement.

WHEREAS, an active and important part of the law enforcement community, he has served as a DARE officer for three years and as a member of the Sheriff's Department SWAT team for ten years, instructed police academy cadets in DUI enforcement, and become a certified hostage negotiator; and

WHEREAS, in addition to his professional service, he has participated in numerous worthy organizations, including the PTA, the Boy Scouts of America, and the Explorers; and

WHEREAS, in his retirement, he is looking forward to spending more time with his beloved wife and family and embarking on new endeavors, such as developing a film production company with his son in Orlando, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Captain Huffine exemplifies the spirit and allegiance to family and community that are characteristic of a true Tennessean; and

WHEREAS, throughout his estimable career, Captain John Huffine has demonstrated the utmost professionalism, ability, and integrity, winning the unbridled respect and admiration of his colleagues; now, therefore,
