WHEREAS, his success as an active member of the 4-H program led him to pursue further education at Vanderbilt University and Tennessee Technological University, and he competed on the shooting teams of both schools; he is a retired engineer, and his experience has brought creativity and structure to all of his chosen endeavors; and

WHEREAS, a renowned leader in 4-H and his community, Mike Glasgow conducts training classes and assists with shooting sports activities across the State, including Target SMART Camp and competitions; he also participates in the local air rifle and "On My Own" programs and as a member of the State 4-H Shooting Sports Committee, which he joined in 2017; and

WHEREAS, an inspiration to those who are fortunate to know him, Mr. Glasgow was instrumental in working alongside the National Rifle Association to obtain much-needed equipment for the county's program; and

WHEREAS, his many professional accomplishments aside, Mr. Glasgow is most grateful for the love and support of his wife, Mary, his two children, and his two grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, the success of this State, the strength of our communities, and the overall vitality of American society depend, in great measure, upon the dedication of people such as Mike Glasgow, who use their considerable talents and resources to serve others and who should be specially recognized for their public and community service; now, therefore,
