

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 1668

A RESOLUTION to recognize Cindy Briley, Sumner County Register of Deeds, on the occasion of her retirement.

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that the members of this General Assembly should honor those citizens who have performed with uncommon devotion and enthusiasm throughout their years of public service; and

WHEREAS, one such estimable person is Cindy Briley, who, having admirably served the citizens of Sumner County as Register of Deeds since 2015, recently announced her intention to retire; and

WHEREAS, a native of Portland, Ms. Briley has devoted thirty-four years of her estimable career to service in Sumner County Government; and

WHEREAS, Cindy Briley served with acumen and alacrity in the Sumner County Trustee's Office for twelve years prior to accepting employment in Portland; after four years in that position, she returned to work for Sumner County as an employee of the environmental department and became a chief deputy in the Register of Deed's Office in 2003; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Briley was appointed to serve as Sumner County Register of Deeds in 2015 and won election to the office in 2016; and

WHEREAS, while the county has grown exponentially over the years, her office staff has not, as she manages a staff of seven employees, which is the same number of employees her office had in 2003; and

WHEREAS, one of the many ways Ms. Briley and her staff have handled the increasing workload is by digitizing and indexing her office's voluminous number of deeds and documents to make them available online; and

WHEREAS, throughout her illustrious tenure as Sumner County Register of Deeds, Cindy Briley has distinguished herself as a public-spirited citizen of the highest order, winning the unbridled respect and admiration of her colleagues and the people she has so ably served; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED TWELFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that we extend to Sumner County Register of Deeds Cindy Briley our heartfelt wishes for a happy and fulfilling retirement and every continued success in her future endeavors.
