A RESOLUTION to honor and commend Coach Stephen Gregg on his 400th win as head coach of the South Greene High School volleyball team.

WHEREAS, Coach Stephen Gregg, head volleyball coach of the Lady Rebels of South Greene High School, recently attained his 400th win, setting yet another record in his outstanding career; and

WHEREAS, the Lady Rebels volleyball team has never finished lower than fourth place under Coach Gregg, advancing through the competition to runner-up finishes in 2013, 2015, 2016, and 2017; and

WHEREAS, record wise, South Greene High School's best season under Coach Gregg came in 2015 at 46-3, and a total of thirteen of his players have been named All-State volleyball players; and

WHEREAS, an exemplary educator who loves the challenge of his profession, Stephen Gregg is most proud of the academic and personal achievements of the student athletes he has coached and mentored during his incredible career and is thankful for the opportunity to have positively influenced so many young lives; and

WHEREAS, Coach Stephen Gregg has distinguished himself as one of the greatest coaches in Tennessee high school volleyball history, and he is most worthy of our approbation; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED TWELFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that we honor and commend Coach Stephen Gregg on his 400th win as head coach of the South Greene High School volleyball team and extend to him our best wishes for much continued success and happiness both on and off the court.
