

SENATE RESOLUTION 20

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Shane Hooper to the Tennessee board of regents.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-8-201, provides for the creation of the Tennessee board of regents; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-8-201, further provides that the governor shall appoint twelve members to the Tennessee board of regents; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Lee has appointed Shane Hooper to the Tennessee board of regents as a member representing Middle Tennessee to a term that will expire on June 30, 2028; and

WHEREAS, a highly successful businessman, Shane Hooper currently serves as the president/chief executive officer of the Shelbyville-Bedford Partnership; he is currently a member of the Lipscomb University Board of Directors and the Tennessee Walking Horse National Celebration Association; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Hooper is a graduate of Itawamba Agricultural High School and Lipscomb University; after his college graduation, he served his country as an officer in the United States Marine Corps and earned a master's degree in economic development from the University of Southern Mississippi; and

WHEREAS, Shane Hooper is a person of integrity and an active citizen whose benevolence, acumen, and strong commitment to public service have helped to enhance the well-being of this State and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-8-201, provides that each member appointed by the governor to the Tennessee board of regents shall be confirmed by the senate; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRTEENTH
GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, that this body does hereby confirm
the appointment of Shane Hooper to the Tennessee board of regents for a term that will expire
on June 30, 2028.
