WHEREAS, this outrageous assault on our sovereignty must be addressed immediately by Washington and the Chinese government officially condemned for its actions; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRTEENTH
GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, that we condemn China for its
invasion of our air space with a spy balloon and support immediate actions be taken to protect
our borders from any future incursion of our air space.
