# **A BILL**

To repeal section 134 of the Clean Air Act, relating to  
the greenhouse gas reduction fund.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF GREENHOUSE GAS REDUCTION**  
4 **FUND.**

5       (a) REPEAL.—Section 134 of the Clean Air Act (42  
6 U.S.C. 7434)(relating to the greenhouse gas reduction  
7 fund) is repealed.

8       (b) RESCISSION.—The unobligated balance of any  
9 amounts made available under section 134 of the Clean  
10 Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7434)(as in effect on the day before  
11 the date of enactment of this Act) is rescinded.

12       (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 60103 of  
13 Public Law 117–169 (relating to the greenhouse gas re-  
14 duction fund) is repealed.
