## A BILL

To prohibit Federal funding to the Wuhan Institute of Virology and to require a GAO study regarding Federal funds previously provided to such institute or to entities affiliated with the Chinese Government.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Defund the Wuhan  
5 Institute of Virology Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FEDERAL FUNDING TO THE**  
2 **WUHAN INSTITUTE OF VIROLOGY.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—No funds authorized or appro-  
4 priated by Federal law may be made available to the  
5 Wuhan Institute of Virology for any purpose.

6 (b) GAO STUDY AND REPORT.—Not later than 2  
7 years after the date of the enactment of this Act, the  
8 Comptroller General of the United States shall conduct  
9 a study and submit a report to Congress regarding the  
10 amount of Federal funds that were awarded or indirectly  
11 provided (whether purposely or inadvertently) during the  
12 15-year period immediately preceding such date of enact-  
13 ment to—

14 (1) the Wuhan Institute of Virology, including  
15 affiliated researchers;

16 (2) the People’s Republic of China;

17 (3) the Chinese Communist Party; or

18 (4) any agency or instrumentality of the entities  
19 listed in paragraphs (1) through (3).
