A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INTERIM HAZARDOUS WASTE PERMITS.**

4 *Section 3005(e) of the Solid Waste Disposal Act (42*
5 *U.S.C. 6925(e)) is amended—*

6 *(1) in paragraph (1)(A)—*

7 *(A) in clause (i), by striking “or” at the*
8 *end;*

9 *(B) in clause (ii), by inserting “or” after*
10 *“this section,”;*

11 *(C) by adding at the end the following:*

12 *“(iii) is a critical energy resource facility,”;*

13 *and*

14 *(2) by adding at the end the following:*

15 *“(4) DEFINITIONS.—For the purposes of this sub-*
16 *section:*

17 *“(A) CRITICAL ENERGY RESOURCE.—The term*
18 *‘critical energy resource’ means, as determined by the*
19 *Secretary of Energy, any energy resource—*

20 *“(i) that is essential to the energy sector*
21 *and energy systems of the United States; and*

22 *“(ii) the supply chain of which is vulner-*
23 *able to disruption.*

24 *“(B) CRITICAL ENERGY RESOURCE FACILITY.—*

25 *The term ‘critical energy resource facility’ means a*
