#### 1 SECTION 1. DEFINITION.

2	In this Act, the term "Arlington Ridge tract" means
3	the parcel of Federal land located in Arlington County,
4	Virginia, known as the Nevius Tract and transferred to
5	the Department of the Interior in 1953, that is bounded
6	generally by—
7	(1) Arlington Boulevard (United States Route
8	50) to the north;
9	(2) Jefferson Davis Highway (Virginia Route
10	110) to the east;
11	(3) Marshall Drive to the south; and
12	(4) North Meade Street to the west.
13	SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF A VISITOR SERVICES FACILITY
14	ON THE ARLINGTON RIDGE TRACT.
15	Notwithstanding section 2863(g) of Public Law 107–
16	107, the Secretary of the Interior is authorized to con-
17	struct a structure for visitor services to include a public
18	restroom facility on the Arlington Ridge tract in the area
19	of the U.S. Marine Corps War Memorial.
