4	Section 241(i) of the Immigration and Nationality
5	Act (8 U.S.C. 1231(i)) is amended by adding at the end
6	the following:
7	"(7) A State (or a political subdivision of a
8	State) shall not be eligible to enter into a contrac-
9	tual arrangement under paragraph (1) if the State
10	(or political subdivision)—
11	"(A) has in effect any law, policy, or proce-
12	dure in contravention of subsection (a) or (b) of
13	section 642 of the Illegal Immigration Reform
14	and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996 (8
15	U.S.C. 1373); or
16	"(B) prohibits State or local law enforce-
17	ment officials from gathering information re-
18	garding the citizenship or immigration status,
19	lawful or unlawful, of any individual.".
