- 4 This Act may be cited as the "CHAMPVA Children's
- 5 Protection Act of 2011".
- 6 SEC. 2. INCREASE OF MAXIMUM AGE FOR CHILDREN ELIGI-
- 7 BLE FOR MEDICAL CARE UNDER CHAMPVA
- 8 PROGRAM.
- 9 (a) Increase.—Section 1781(c) of title 38, United
- 10 States Code, is amended—

1	(1) by striking "twenty-three" and inserting
2	"twenty-six"; and
3	(2) by striking "twenty-third birthday" and in-
4	serting "twenty-sixth birthday".
5	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
6	subsection (a) shall apply with respect to medical care pro-
7	vided on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
