## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to increase the maximum age for children eligible for medical care under the CHAMPVA program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “CHAMPVA Children’s  
5 Protection Act of 2011”.

6 **SEC. 2. INCREASE OF MAXIMUM AGE FOR CHILDREN ELIGI-**  
7 **BLE FOR MEDICAL CARE UNDER CHAMPVA**  
8 **PROGRAM.**

9 (a) INCREASE.—Section 1781(c) of title 38, United  
10 States Code, is amended—

1           (1) by striking “twenty-three” and inserting  
2           “twenty-six”; and

3           (2) by striking “twenty-third birthday” and in-  
4           serting “twenty-sixth birthday”.

5           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by  
6 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to medical care pro-  
7 vided on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
