3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “School Lunch Afford-
5 ability Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIRED PRICE FOR PAID LUNCH.**

2 Section 12(p)(2)(A) of the Richard B. Russell Na-
3 tional School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1760(p)(2)(A)) is
4 amended by inserting “that had a negative balance in the
5 nonprofit school food service account on June 30th of the
6 year preceding the previous school year” after “school
7 food authority”.
