#### A BILL

To amend chapter 21 of title 38, United States Code, to establish a grant program to encourage the development of new assistive technologies for specially adapted housing.

- 4 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the following

- 8 "(a) Establishment.—The Secretary shall make
- 9 grants to encourage the development of new assistive tech-
- 10 nologies for specially adapted housing.
- 11 "(b) APPLICATION.—A person seeking a grant under
- 12 this section shall submit to the Secretary an application
- 13 for the grant in such form and manner as the Secretary
- 14 shall specify.
- 15 "(c) Grant Funds.—(1) The amount of each grant
- 16 awarded under this section shall be an amount of not more
- 17 than \$200,000 per year.
- 18 "(2) For each year in which the Secretary makes a
- 19 grant under this section, the Secretary shall make the grant
- 20 by not later than October 1 of that year.
- 21 "(d) USE OF FUNDS.—(1) The recipient of a grant
- 22 under this section shall use the grant to develop assistive
- 23 technologies for use in specially adapted housing.
- 24 "(2) If the recipient of a grant under this section is
- 25 awarded a patent related to assistive technology developed

- 1 with amounts under the grant, the Secretary shall retain
- 2 not less than a 30 percent interest in such patent.
- 3 "(e) Report.—Not later than March 1 of each year,
- 4 the Secretary shall submit to Congress a report containing
- 5 information related to each grant awarded under this sec-
- 6 tion during the preceding calendar year, including—
- 7 "(1) the name of the grant recipient;
- 8 "(2) the amount of the grant; and
- 9 "(3) the goal of the grant.
- 10 "(f) Funding.—From amounts appropriated to the
- 11 Department for Medical Services for each fiscal year,
- 12 \$2,000,000 shall be available for each such fiscal year for
- 13 the purposes of the program under this section.
- 14 "(g) Termination.—The authority to make a grant
- 15 under this section shall terminate on the date that is five
- 16 years after the date of the enactment of this section.".
- 17 (b) Clerical Amendment.—The table of sections at
- 18 the beginning of chapter 21 of title 38, United States Code,
- 19 is amended by adding at the end the following:

"2108. Specially adapted housing assistive technology grant program.".

- 20 (c) Deadline for Implementation.—The Secretary
- 21 shall implement the grant program under section 2108 of
- 22 title 38, United States Code, as added by subsection (a),
- 23 by not later than 180 days after the date of the enactment
- 24 of this Act.

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
