- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Congressional Budget

5	(a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
6	sion of law, any amounts appropriated for Members' Rep-
7	resentational Allowances for the House of Representatives
8	for a fiscal year which remain after all payments are made
9	under such Allowances for the year shall be deposited in
10	the Treasury and used for deficit reduction, except that
11	in the case of a fiscal year for which there is no Federal
12	budget deficit, such amounts shall be used to reduce the
13	Federal debt (in such manner as the Secretary of the
14	Treasury considers appropriate).
15	(b) REGULATIONS.—The Committee on House Ad-
16	ministration shall promulgate such regulations as may be
17	necessary to carry out this section.
18	(c) Effective Date.—This section shall apply with
19	respect to fiscal year 2011 and each succeeding fiscal year.
