3 SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF MEMBER OF SPECIAL EXPO-4 SURE COHORT.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 3621(14) of the Energy
6 Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program
7 Act of 2000 (42 U.S.C. 7384l(14)) is amended by adding
8 at the end the following new subparagraph:

"(D) The employee was so employed for a
 number of work days aggregating at least 250
 work days before January 1, 2006, by the De partment of Energy or a Department of Energy
 contractor or subcontractor at the Santa
 Susana Field Laboratory in California.".

7 (b) REAPPLICATION.—A claim that an individual qualifies, by reason of section 3621(14)(D) of the Energy 8 9 Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program Act of 2000 (as added by subsection (a) of this Act), for 10 11 compensation or benefits under such Act shall be consid-12 ered for compensation or benefits notwithstanding any denial of any other claim for compensation with respect to 13 such individual. 14
