A BILL

To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to require a Federal medical assistance percentage of 100 percent for urban Indian organizations, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Urban Indian Health
5 Parity Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. FULL FEDERAL MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PERCENT-**
2 **AGE FOR URBAN INDIAN ORGANIZATIONS.**

3 Section 1905(b) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
4 1396d(b)) is amended by inserting after “by an Indian
5 tribe or tribal organization (as defined in section 4 of the
6 Indian Health Care Improvement Act)” the following: “,
7 or through an urban Indian organization (as defined in
8 section 4 of such Act) pursuant to a grant or contract
9 with the Indian Health Service under title V of the Indian
10 Health Care Improvement Act”.

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
